Stephanie Watson was born in Zambia and studied at the Johannesburg School of Art and Visual Arts Research.

This will be Miss Watson's thirteenth one-man exhibition. She has exhibited at Gallery 101 and Gallery 21 in Johannesburg; the Walsh Marais Gallery, Durban; the Association of Arts, Cape Town and Pretoria and the William Humphreys Gallery, Kimberley. Some of her work has found its way into the exhibition Fame and Promise, the S.A. Breweries Biennale, the Quinquennial, the Republican Festival, Century of South African Art 1869–1969, the Winter Art Show and Group 51.

Her works are included in the collections of the S.A. National Gallery, Cape Town, the National Department of Education and the Schlesinger Organisation. The S.A. Breweries commissioned her to do a number of silkscreens for their hotels.
